'Moses' the Lorry off to Moldova !

Last year , Crosshall Infant School became very involved in sending out a lorry named 'Percy' to Moldova. The lorry contained humanitarian aid for the people in Burlacu Village.

Our School has developed close links with the two schools in the village and after the visit in May by Mrs. Smith these links have been strengthened.

Mrs. Smith was able to talk to staff at the schools to ascertain their needs. To support the development of the schools, the next lorry is being prepared to be sent out on October 4th. This lorry, called 'Moses', will mostly contain supplies for the schools and the children of the village.

We have already collected some school furniture including tables, chairs, easels etc. Computers have also been donated.

However both the Kindergarten (ages 3-7) and the school (ages 7-18) are in desperate need of paper, art and craft resources, good quality educational toys and

equipment.

At Crosshall Infant school we use a laminator to protect and preserve teaching materials. It is felt that this too would be a very useful gift for the schools so that they could prepare and re-use resources in a similar way.

We would like to be able to send as many resources as we can to Moldova and so we are proposing to have a fund-raising day on
